General/Universal

-dissemination and distance trainings to build basic knowledge, increase identification and awareness

Targeted/Specialized

-training activities delivered both in-person and through distance technologies based on affirmed statewide initiatives

Intensive/Sustained

-personalized TA to identified and committed stakeholders delivered across all five initiatives

NYDBC INITIATIVES

Early Identification & Referral

-To increase the number of children who are deaf-blind, between the ages of 0-3 and improve developmental and functional outcomes for children who are deaf-blind.

Instructional Practice

-To increase the number of students receiving instruction from educational teams using evidence based practices that will lead to improved academic and functional outcomes.

Families

-To increase productive partnerships between families & service providers and family advocacy efforts leading to evidence based practices in home, school, and community.

Related Services

*-Interveners
-Hearing & Vision Providers*

-To increase the number of certified interveners in NYS & increase the number of vision and hearing providers implementing evidence based practices with children and youth who are deaf-blind.

Transition

-To increase systems addressing the unique needs of families of young adults who are deaf-blind & increase the number of valued life outcomes in work, community, home, and post-
